Scope of Works: Theatres 1 & 2 AHU Replacement

This complex project mainly comprised the replacement of the air handling plant serving two existing theatres at Musgrove Park Hospital.

The use of one theatre is designated as one of the hospital's emergency theatres and its continued use was vital to the operation of the hospital. Consequently, the process of replacing the ventilation and associated equipment was based on installing new plant in alternative locations and then organising very short planned shut downs for the theatres whilst the ventilation and other services were switched over to the new plant and equipment.

Careful planning and a close working relationship with Kier Western and the Client was crucial to the successful handover of this project on time and within budget.
