The St Anthony's Building at Buckfast Abbey is a historic Grade II listed former farm building and later used as the Tonic Wine and Honey Department for the Abbey. Refurbished in 2014 to a modern office for the Abbey's Financial, Works, IT and Record Departments, with glass and oak throughout the 3storey building. The building has a sleek and modern feel internally whilst still maintaining its historic look externally.

Totus were engaged to provide a completely new mechanical and

electrical service installation with the latest in LED lighting technology, daylight linked lighting controls, solar panel PV generation and Cat 6A data wiring combined with underfloor heating, air condition and ventilation; the services within this heavily serviced building were concealed within the buildings fabric and only installed surface in some areas to maintain the existing features of this historic building.

The refurbishment works were completed in August 2014 marked with a blessing ceremony carried out by the Abbey.
